Eynesbury Church has been a landmark and gathering place of the Eynesbury Community for over 800 years.

As well as regular worship, the building has witnessed the baptisms, marriages and funerals of generations of residents and we hope it will continue to do so for many years to come.

Maintaining a Grade II* listed building is an expensive task and so the Eynesbury Parochial Church Council has a 50/50 Club to help raise funds to maintain the church.

For £60 a year you can help Preserve Our Heritage.

To be a member of the club you pay £5 monthly, £15 quarterly or £60 annually to have one ticket in the quarterly draw.

You may purchase as many tickets as you wish.

The money raised each quarter is divided equally between the church and two prize winners.

The first prize will be twice as much as the second prize.

For example with 32 tickets sold the amount to the church will be £240.00; first prize will be £160.00 and second prize £80.00

The draws are held on the first Sunday of January, April, July and October between the services
